Kathleen O. Maul Campus Dedicated



Hauppauge, NY -- Through the original foresight and vision, of former United Cerebral Palsy Association of Suffolk, Inc. Executive Director, Kathleen O. Maul, property was secured in Central Islip almost 10 years ago for future use by the agency. A fully accessible, comprehensive Health Center was built on the property and became operational in December 2008. This week, during a brief ceremony attended by her family and friends, participants and employees, a large, engraved stone was placed with great pride by the flagpole outside the Health Center dedicating the Kathleen O. Maul Campus in Central Islip in her memory.

In his remarks, current President and CEO Stephen H. Friedman reflected on Kathleen O. Maul's dream for the parcel of land and noted, "This center will be a permanent, living tribute to Kathy's unwavering commitment to equality and accessibility for people with disabilities."
